



## **Barnardos Public Compliance Statement**

**Barnardos is committed to complying with the *Statement for Guiding Principles for Fundraising* and has formally discussed and adopted the Statement at a meeting of the governing body.**

- Barnardos confirms its commitment to the principles set out in the *Statement of Guiding Principles for Fundraising* by a statement to that effect in our annual report.
- Barnardos has a Donor Charter which is consistent with the *Statement of Guiding Principles for Fundraising*.
- Barnardos regularly monitors compliance with the *Statement of Guiding Principles for Fundraising* and compliance reports are received regularly by the governing body.
- Barnardos considers the *Statement of Guiding Principles for Fundraising* when planning all fundraising activity.
- Barnardos has a policy on working with third party fundraisers.
- Barnardos provides honest, open and transparent disclosure when fundraising from the public.
- Barnardos has appointed a member of the governing body and/or a senior member of staff to be responsible for compliance with the *Statement of Guiding Principles for Fundraising*
- Barnardos ensures that fundraising staff are provided with information and training on the Statement of Guiding Principles for Fundraising and its implementation.
- Barnardos has a feedback and complaints procedure consistent with the *Statement of Guiding Principles for Fundraising*. Feedback is recorded for review by relevant staff including the CEO and governing body. Feedback is responded to promptly and appropriately.
- Barnardos prepares financial reports consistent with the requirements of the Charities Act 2009 which include a statement concerning the extent to which control of the organisation is independent of its funding sources.
- Barnardos ensures that all donations are tracked and recorded and complies with data protection requirements.
- Barnardos is accessible to the public through a number of readily available contact options.
