

Supporting Barnardos in 2023



At Barnardos, we have been helping vulnerable children in Ireland since the 1960s.

Our core purpose is to help the most vulnerable children in society achieve their full potential – regardless of their family circumstances, their gender, race or disability.

Our ambition is to deliver a wider range of services and supports that transform the lives of children. As a trauma informed specialist organisation we have embedded this ethos and practice into all aspects of how we work, including staff training and how our service centres look.

This practice encourages more families to self-refer when they are struggling and know that Barnardos service centres are welcoming, nurturing environments, that are non-judgemental and child focused in our approach. This ensures more vulnerable children in Ireland get the support they need to overcome childhood adversity.



What is Trauma informed work?

Being Trauma-informed is about asking what's happened to a person and not what's wrong with them. It recognises the complex nature and affects of trauma on people's lives and promotes resilience and healing. It has 6 core principles: safety, trustworthiness, choice, collaboration, empowerment and respect for diversity.

What are Adverse Childhood Experiences (ACE's)?

Barnardos supports children who are affected by adverse childhood experiences such as abuse, parental mental health, neglect, addiction, domestic violence, parental separation and bereavement. These traumatic events can have negative lasting effects on development, health and well being. Without intervention, children with 4 or more ACE's are more likely to experience depression, addiction, attempt suicide, have lung and liver disease* and this creates more future societal problems.





Barnardos work with children and families

Barnardos supports children who may have experienced these adversities on a daily basis and recognise their parents may also have experienced trauma as a child. We work with over 17,000 children and families building resilience and coping skills and developing social & emotional skills to support their learning and with families strengthening parenting skills, daily routines and understanding their child's needs.

Our project workers do this through our Early Intervention Work, Family Support Services, Bereavement Service, Post Adoption Support for children and adults, Origins Tracing Service, Teen Parents, Mother & Baby groups, Support Service for Parents of Children in Care, Family Resource Centres, TLC Kidz Domestic Violence Service & our volunteer lead "Wizard of Words" literacy programme and "Roots of Empathy" programme for primary school children.

26% of the children Barnardos work with are under 5 years of age.


Basic physiological needs of a child are Food, Water, Warmth & Rest.
