

Supporting Professional Practice through One-to-One Supervision in ELC and SAC



Overview

This workshop is suitable for those working in Early Learning and Care and School Age Childcare who are currently supervising staff and students there. The aim of the workshop is to give guidance on the development and implementation of supervision structures in your setting.

Supervision is an important feature in addressing the needs of children, families, staff, management and funders. It supports the professional development of individuals within the team and also puts in place processes to meet regulatory requirements on staff supervision.
